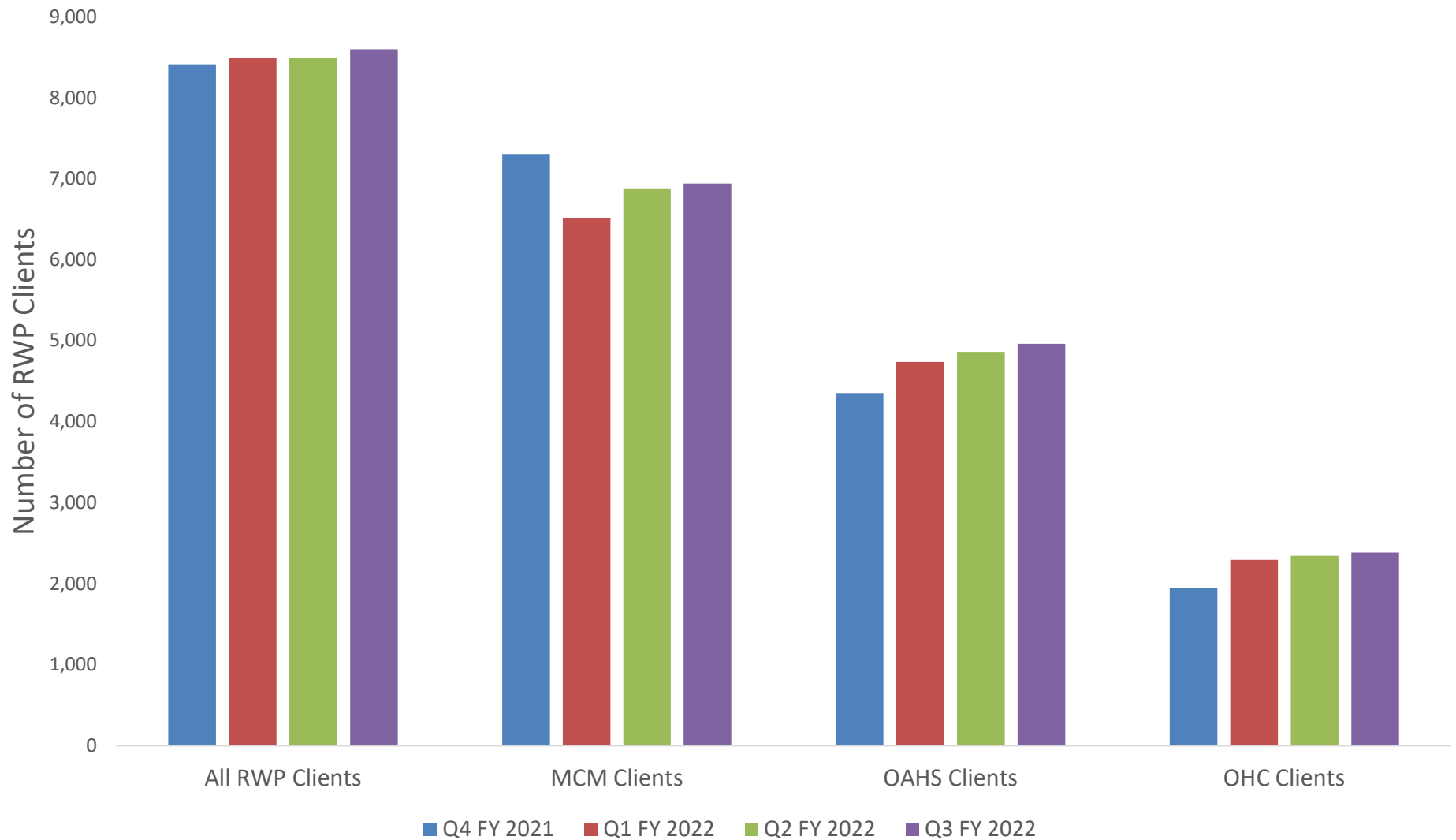
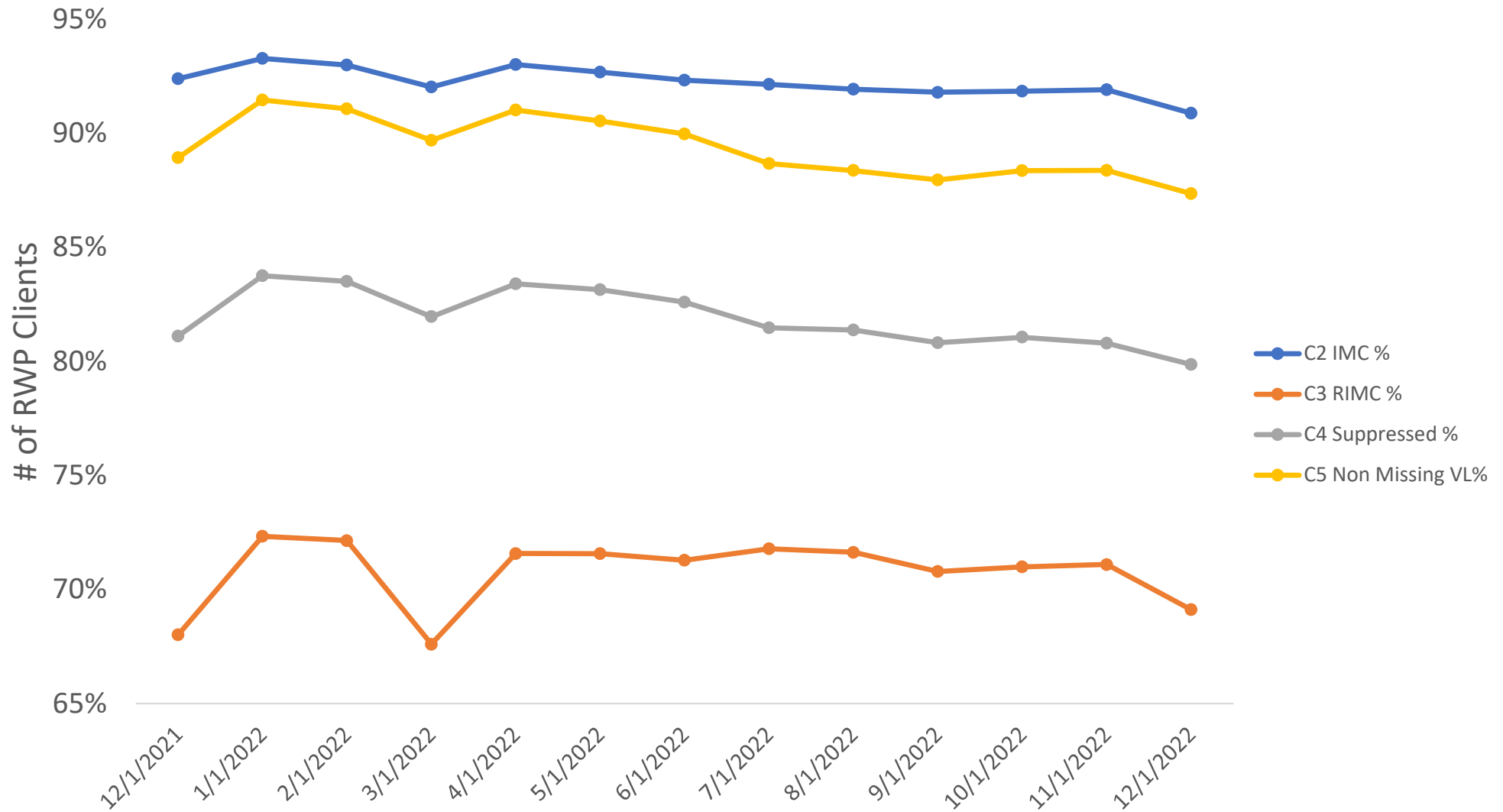


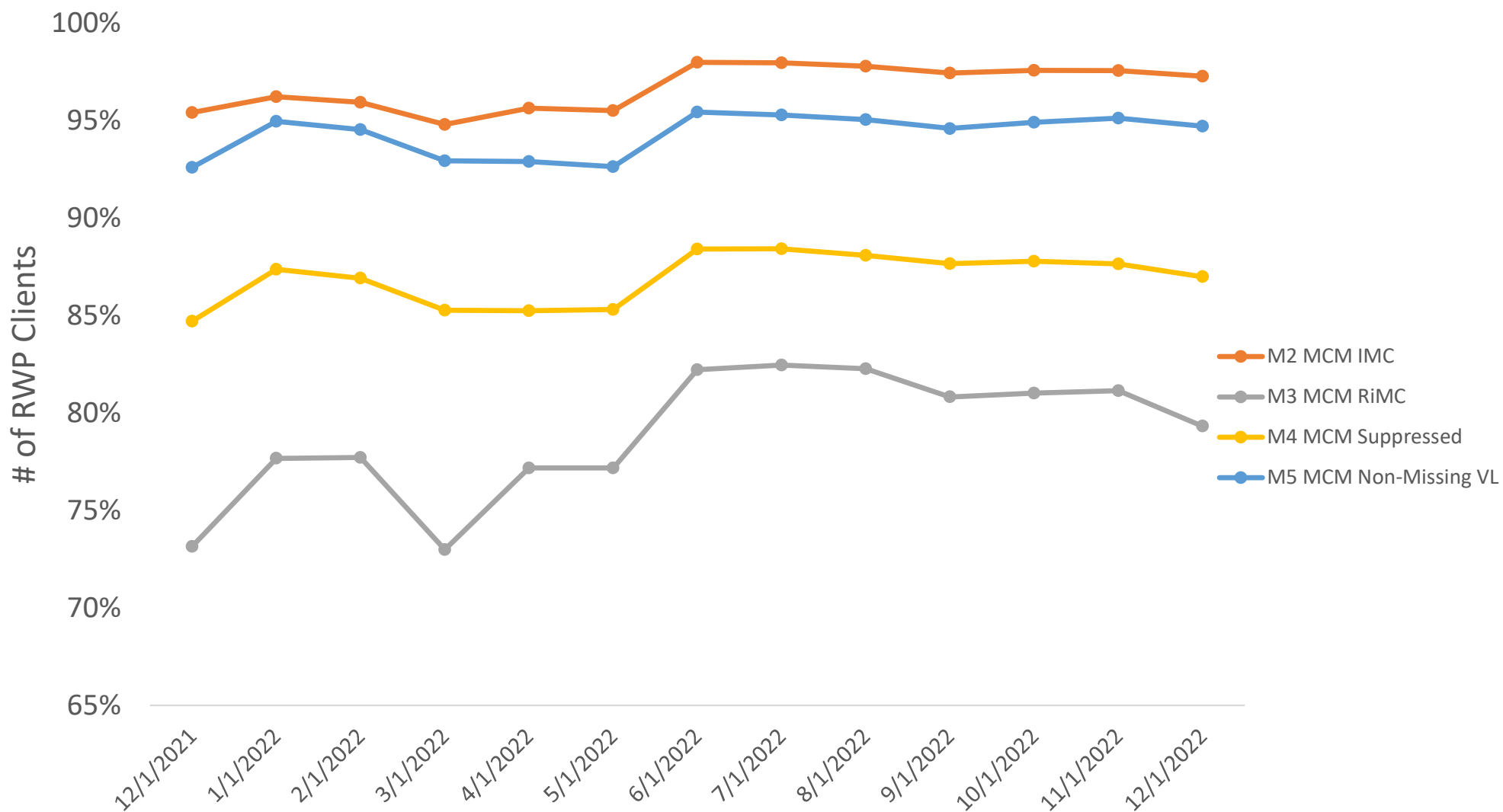
Number of Clients in Ryan White Program By Service Category Per Quarter



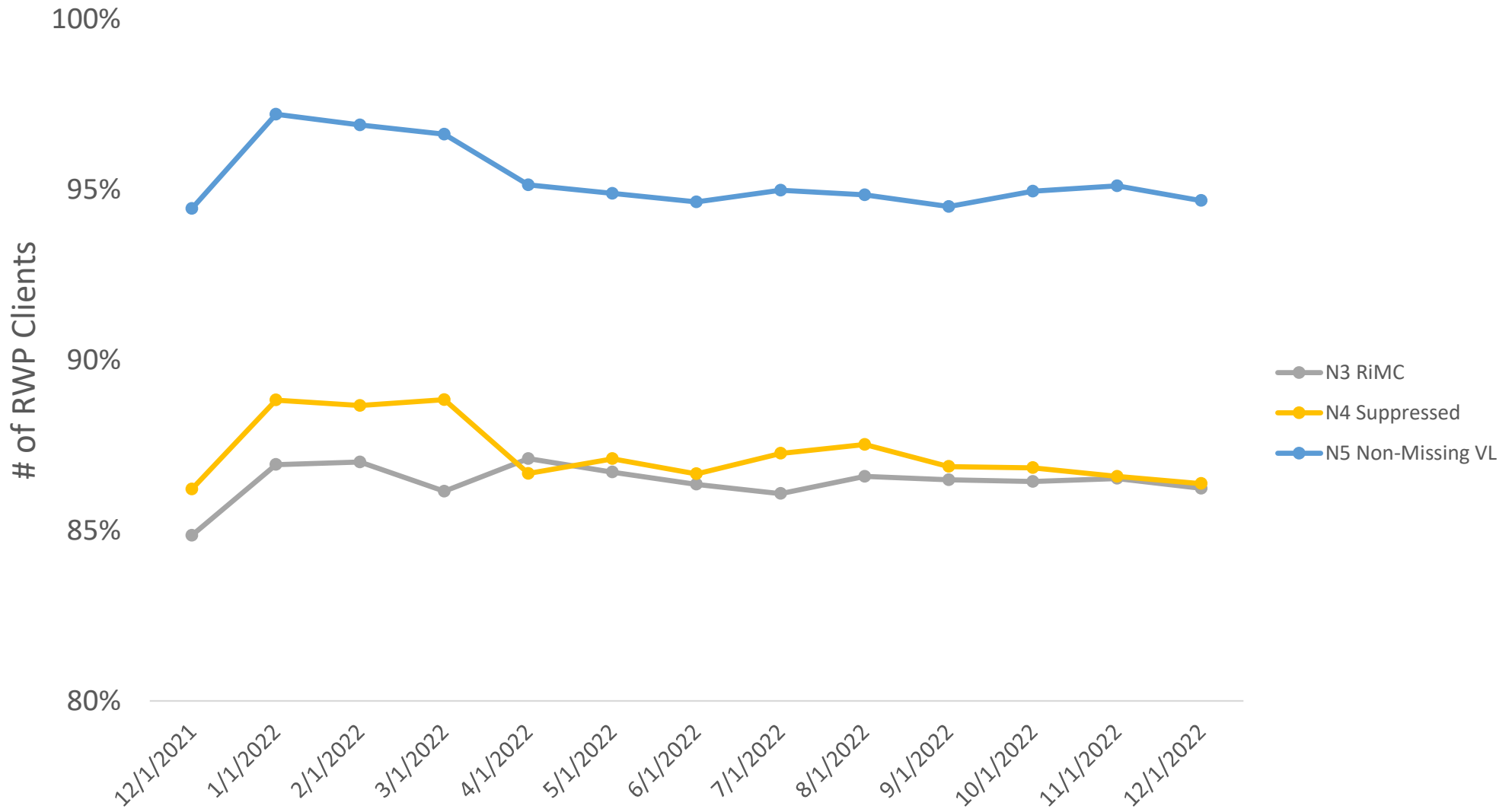
RWP Care Continuum Variables as a Percent Of Clients In Care



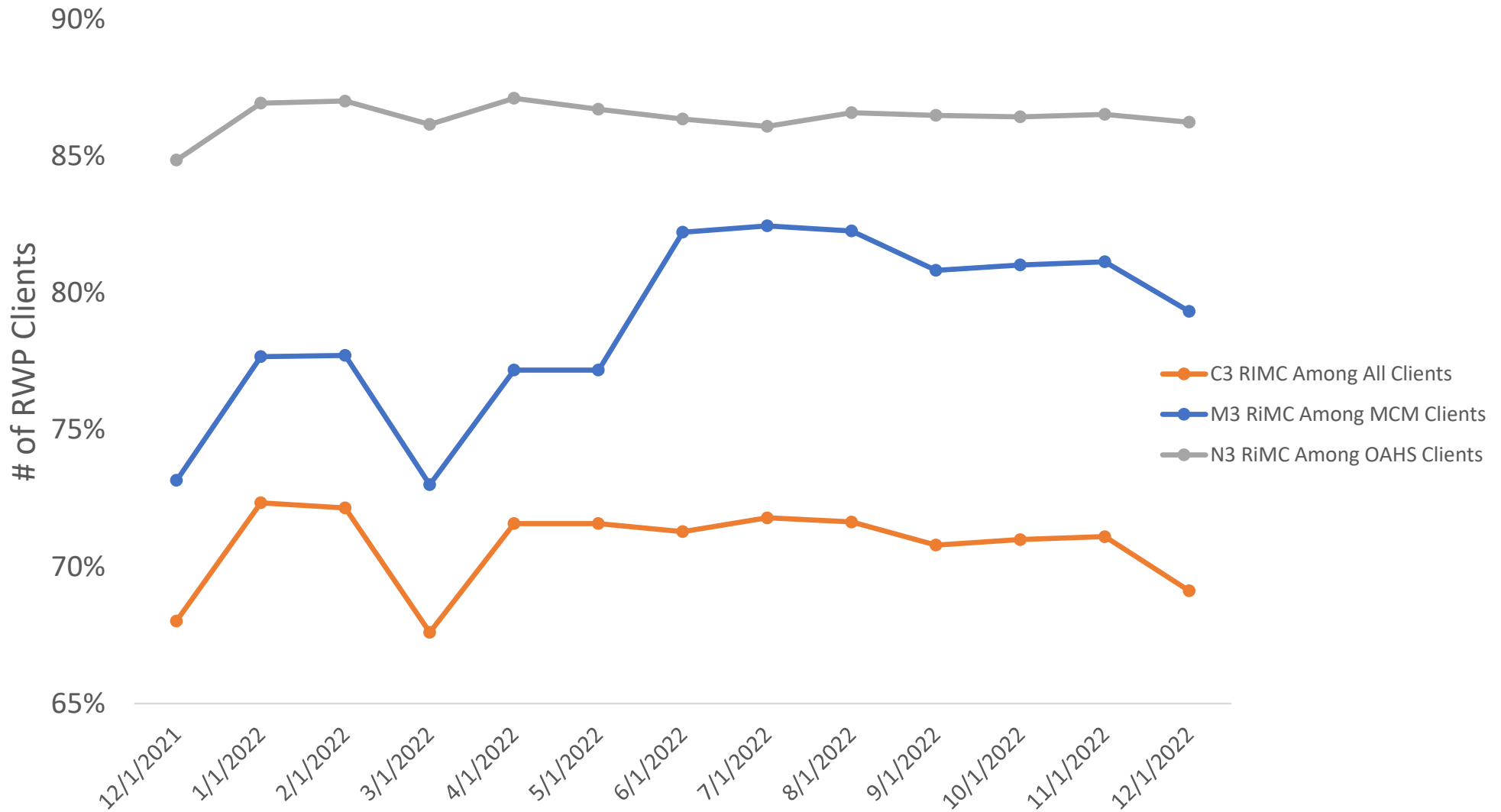
RWP MCM Variables as a Percent Of Clients In MCM Care



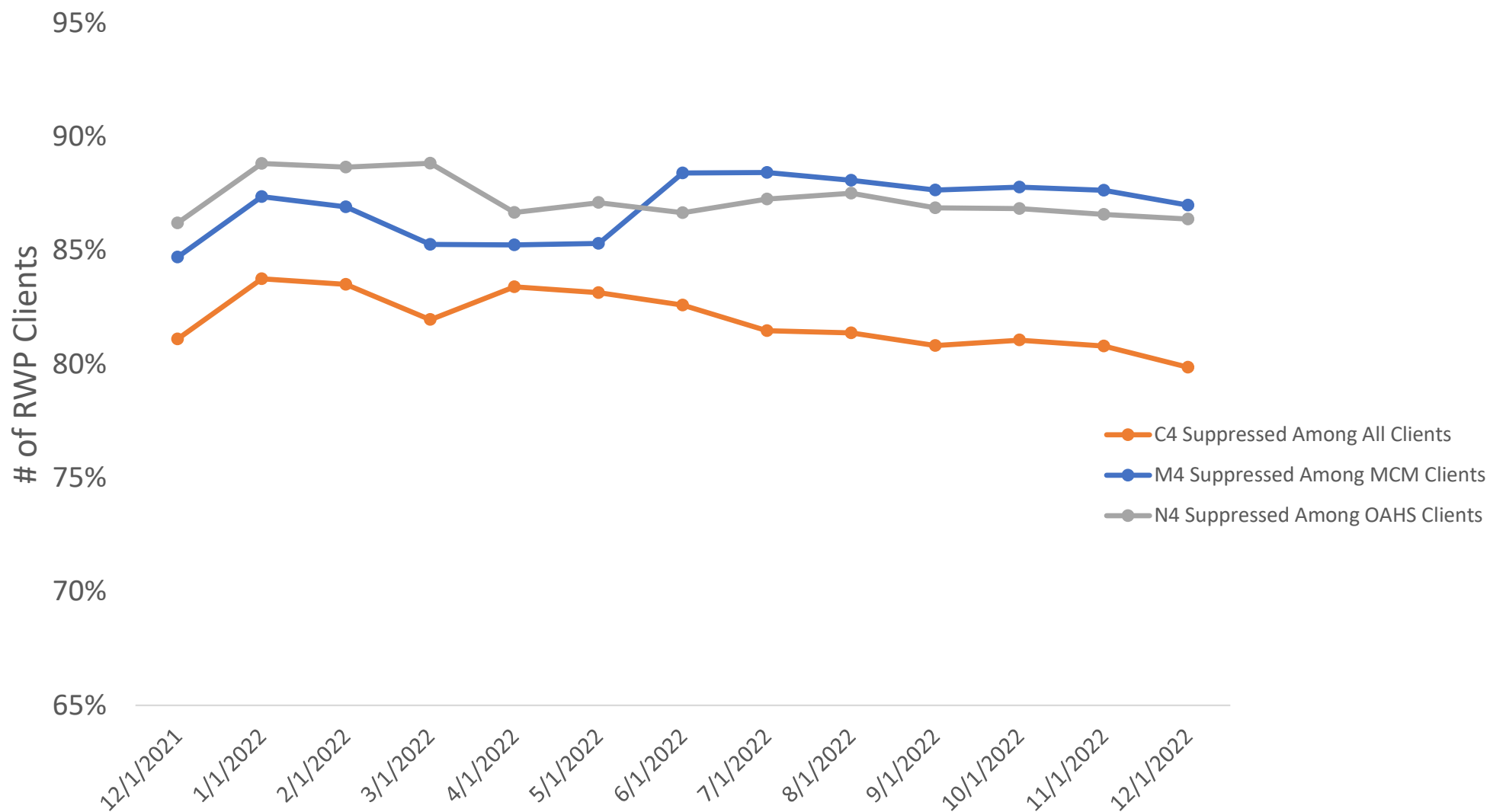
RWP OAHS Variables as a Percent Of Clients In OAHS Care



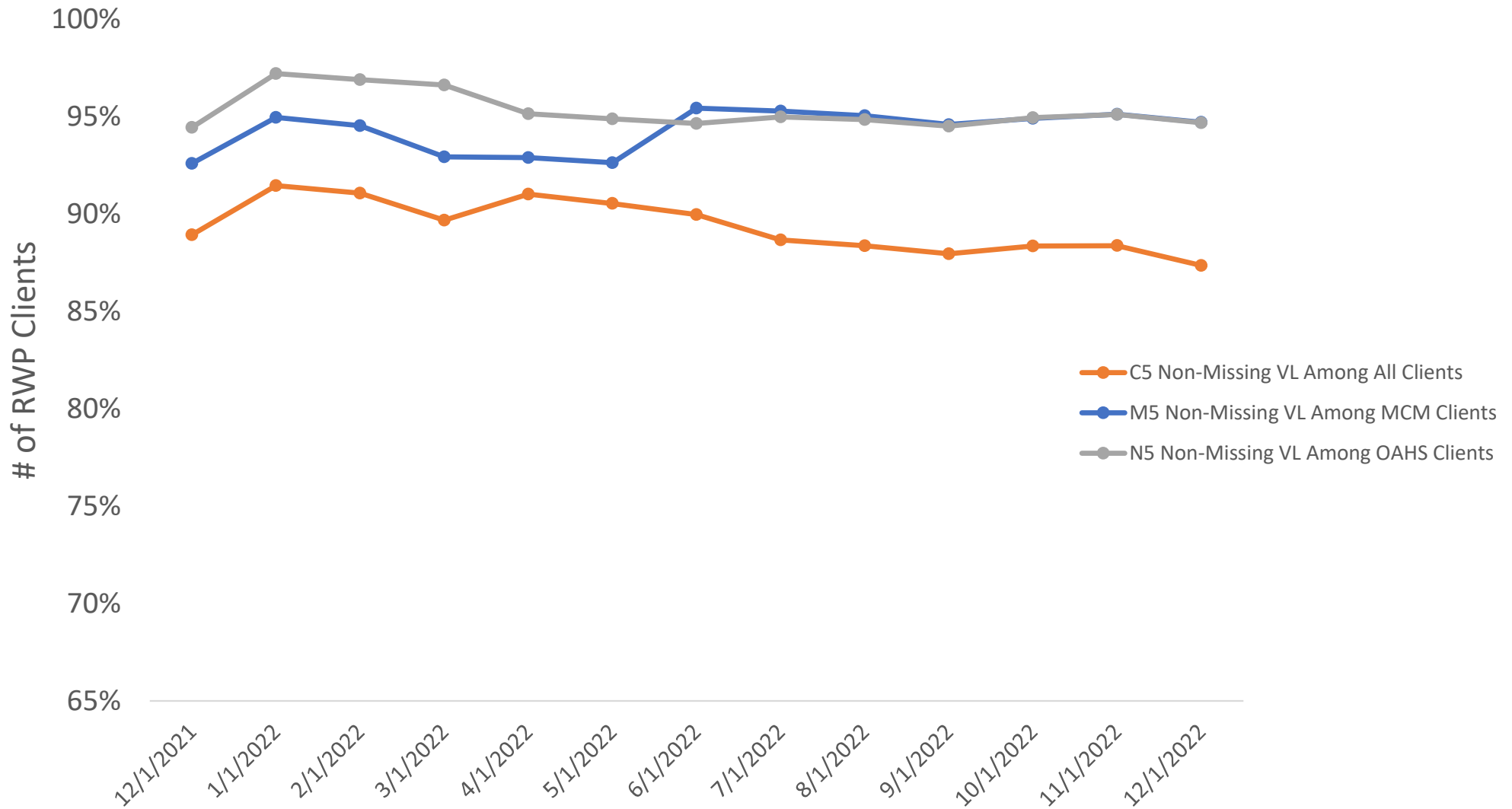
RWP RiMC as a Percent Of Clients

- Disease Care Management (DCM)
 - Licensed RNs as care coordinators
 - Clinical experience with social knowledge
 - Provide education about HIV and other medical conditions
 - Assist clients who have medical comorbidities
 - Monitor adherence to medical care and medications
 - Assists clients with medical referrals

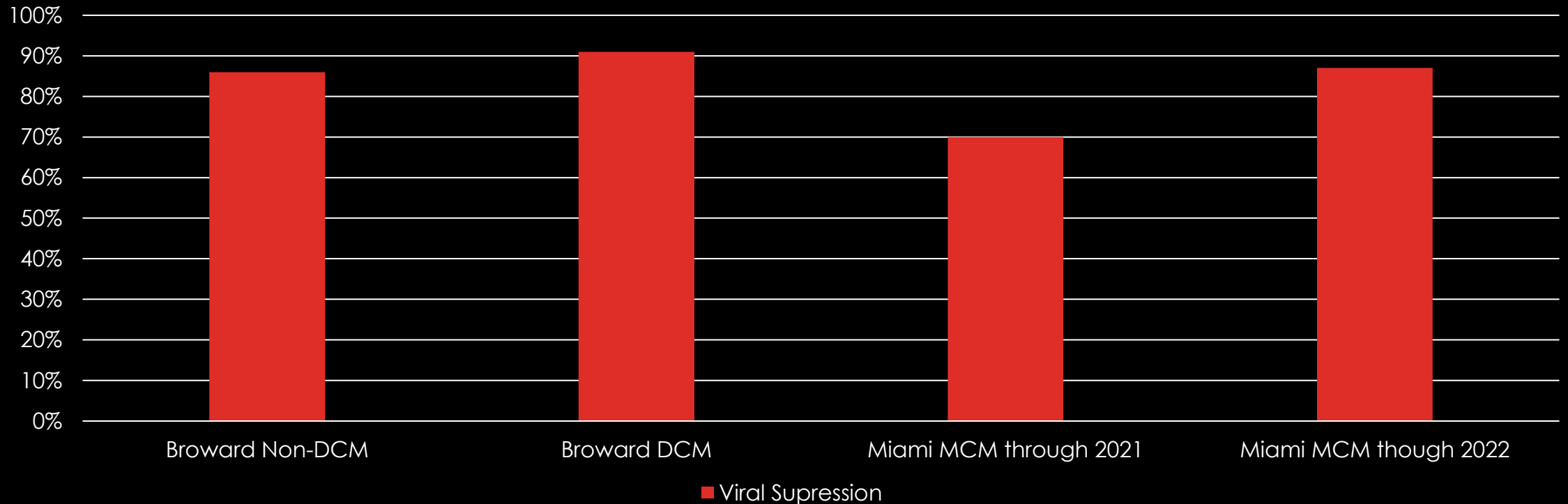

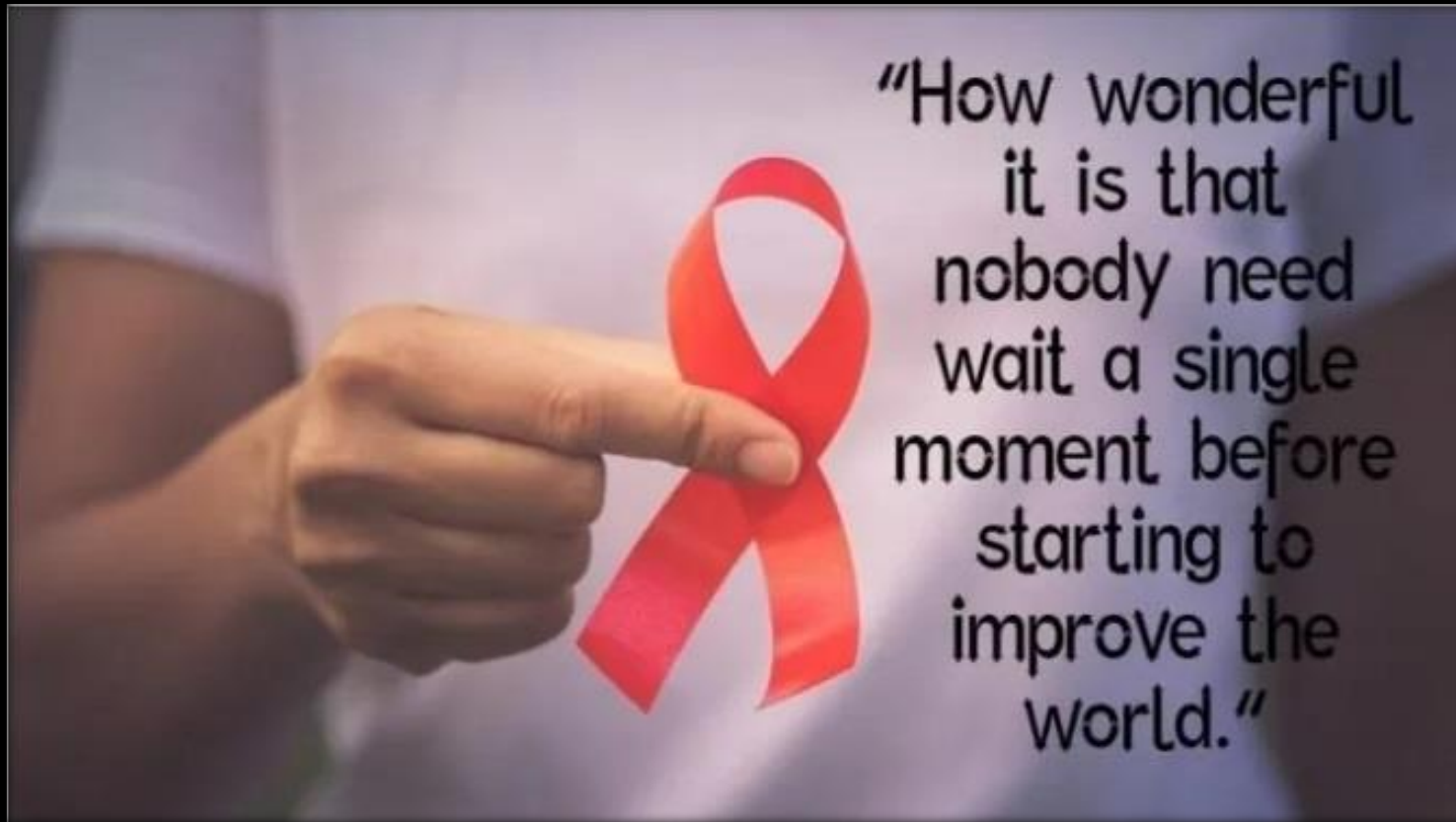

 - Clients with comorbid conditions
- Disease care managers encourage Affordable Health Act (ACA) and explain its benefits
- Educate about the benefits of and provide referrals to all available Ryan White services
- Care Conferences between the Providers, Disease Care Managers, and the rest of the team regarding specific clients and situations

The University Health Truman Medical Center, affiliated with the University of Missouri-Kansas City established a bilingual and bicultural care team that consists of a peer educator, case manager, and clinician. The care team provides clients with culturally responsive care and links them to external community resources. Hispanic and Latina(o/x) clients served by the bilingual and bicultural care team experienced greater retention in care and improved viral suppression rates.

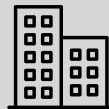
