The Committee was reminded of the resource allocation process and that they had decided only to generate ceiling budgets for Part A and MAI. Based on data presented throughout the process including the Dashboard Cards, projections data, and potential changes to service delivery because of the upcoming RFP, the Committee developed a single ceiling grant budget for Part A, including additional funds to the mental health service category since psychiatry will be moved into this service category to better align with policy clarification notice #16-02. Under MAI, the Committee also took into consideration that services are intended to create a targeted program for minority groups, therefore they focused funding on five service categories that would be bundled to create one. Final allocations were as indicated below.
